Every time you buy, sell, or take a loan on your property, Los Angeles County sends you a copy of the recorded document. This gives you a chance to review the document to be sure that it is correct. The copy is sent to the property address and any other address on file at the County Assessor's Office.

Please check the enclosed document to be sure it is correct. If it is correct, there is nothing you need to do. If something is wrong with the document, call the Department of Consumer Affairs.

To help you check the document, please read the blue sheet. It explains the most common types of real estate documents and what they do.

The enclosed document is an unofficial copy. It may be reduced in size and appear different from the original. The original of the enclosed document will be sent to the address that appears in the upper left hand corner of the document.
